4. When you *extract* a tree stump, do you bury it in the ground or pull it out?

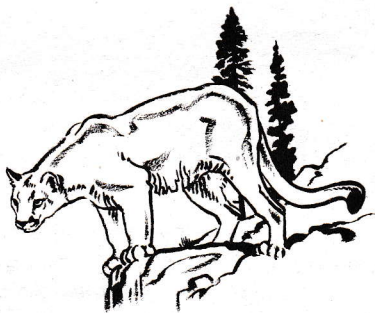
You pull it out.
